

Walter B. Denny is Distinguished Professor of the History of Art and Architecture Emeritus at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst, specializing in the art of the Islamic world. From 1970 to 2000, he was Honorary Curator of Islamic Carpets at the Fogg Museum, and from 2007 to 2017 he served as Senior Consultant in the Department of Islamic Art at the Metropolitan Museum of Art. He completed his Ph.D. dissertation at Harvard in 1970, beginning his teaching career at UMass/Amherst in September of that year, and retiring in May 2023. He continues to consult and to give lectures on a variety of topics in the U.S. and abroad. He is currently Chair of the Visiting Committee for the Department of Textile Conservation at the Metropolitan Museum of Art.
